

City of Santa Clarita Supplemental Questionnaire

The City of Santa Clarita (the "City") has identified the position for which you are applying as being subject to California Public Resources Code Section 5164. Under Section 5164, the City is prohibited from hiring you as an employee in this position if you have received certain felony or misdemeanor convictions within a specified time period. Your selection for this position will also be contingent on a criminal record check in accordance with City policy for submitting applicants' fingerprints to the California Department of Justice.
